Masking Guidance:

In light of the information from the CDC and Mass. DPH, the governor has issued some revised mask guidance to maximize protection of vulnerable individuals from the COVID D variant. The DPH now advises that fully vaccinated people should wear a mask, or face covering, when indoors if you have a weakened immune system, or if you are at risk for severe disease or have some underlying medical condition, or if someone in your household has a weakened immune system, or is at increased risk of severe disease, or is unvaccinated, or if someone you live with someone who is vulnerable to COVID – someone with a significant medical condition, then be careful and wear a mask if you believe it is the right thing to do for unvaccinated adults, or for any vaccinated person who has an unvaccinated adult in their household. Thus, **our bottom line is this:** Wear a mask if you feel comfortable doing so, whether vaccinated or not, or have immunity from having COVID, to protect yourself or loved one. You are not required to wear a mask, but you may wear a mask if you wish to do so. Your choice is right for you and us.
