

#### HOPE FOR HOUSING





For the past 15 years, Greendale People's Church has been

supportive of the Hope for Housing Program. This is a non-profit program developed by the Interfaith Coalition to Prevent Family Homelessness with assistance from the Central Massachusetts Housing Alliance (CMHA) to help people stay in their homes. The project raises awareness about homelessness and utilizes the collective buying power of more than 30 congregations to raise money for the prevention of family homelessness. The fastest-growing homeless population is children. It has been demonstrated that children who are homeless experience deflated selfworth, diminished school achievement, and related health and emotional issues.

Gift cards for local retailers, including Amazon, Big Y, CVS, Dunkin' Donuts, Hannaford, Panera, Shaws, Starbucks, Stop & Shop, TJ Maxx, and Target are purchased in bulk by the CMHA, that in turn are sold to members of our congregation. The retailers donate 2-10% of all sales to the Hope for Housing program to assist families at risk of homelessness.

# Ukrainian Relief

Checks may be mailed or dropped in the mailbox at the church or in the giving plate on On June 30, all donations will be totaled and a check will be sent to ICCC payable to Church World Services for Ukrainian Relief. # 125th Anniversary Celebration: Where are we now?

It has been 18 months since our campaign began in October 2020. Our goal is \$125,000 to cover the cost of replacing boilers and the retaining wall behind the

church, external signage, and funds to support the salary of our pastor. The plan is to continue the campaign through September 2023. So far we have collected \$35,111 of our goal from pledges and miscellaneous campaign donations. With these funds, one boiler and the retaining wall have been replaced.

There is still some work to do, but to accomplish this your help is needed. ### **Summer Altar Flowers**


