March Pastor Corner

Believe the Good News?

esus proclaimed, 'The Kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news' (Mark 1:15). As it turned out, those who rejected Jesus' good vastly outewanbered those who embraced it. Why? I am convinced, thanks to Anthony de Mello (a Jesuit priest), that Jesus was rejected not because what he said was good, but because it was new. We hate the new, de Mello claims, because it demands that we change and admit that we were wrong in at least some of our old ideas. Who likes that? So, we reject the new."

De Mello advises that we should attempt to listen better when someone is preaching or teaching. By this he does NOT mean to listen to the words of the preacher. Rather, **listen to yourself as you listen.** Listen to your reactions. Are you agitated? Okay, why? Are you offended? Okay, why? Are you overjoyed? Okay, why? What do these reactions say about you? Listen, learn.

Almost invariably, you will reject preaching because it is new or because it does not make you feel better about yourself in that instant. And you will embrace heartily what you already believe or want to believe about yourself. Do you know that one preacher, preaching one sermon, can cause as many different reactions as there are people in the congregation? Some reject. Some embrace. WHY? Preaching always says as much about the one listening as it does about the one speaking. You can gain great insight into yourself by listening to your reactions to what you hear from a preacher.

Several years ago, I went to a counselor when I was having a tough time in life. The counselor kept asking, when I talked about my circumstances, "how does that make you feel?" Again and again, no matter what I said or what



the topic was, he asked me, "how does that make you feel?" One time, I looked at all the diplomas and certificates on his wall. It seemed to me that he had wasted a lot of time in school and in training to come to the point where all he said was, "how does that make you feel?" He needs some new tools in his toolbox, I thought.

Eventually, I caught on to what he was doing. He wanted me to listen to myself and learn. Socrates said, "Know yourself!" And, "The unexamined life is not worth living." Those who know themselves are able to respond to life in the most appropriate way. They are not tossed about emotionally by everything they see or hear. They can rise above their circumstances rationally, without being so affected by what others say or do.

In summary, you can get quite a lot out of my preaching – not so much by what I say but by listening to your reactions to what I say. You may discover that you are quite an interesting topic to learn. For me, it is fun to gain insights into myself, even after all these years. Try it yourself.


