

#### Here is some feedback from last week's GB meeting:

a. The Mass DEP has issued us a Consent Order with a suspense of 10 July 2022 for Camp Selah regarding plans to ensure safe water consumption for our, and YMCA, use of the public water system. There are nine (9) specific requirements in the Order. We are hiring a water testing company to help us comply with all the technical, emergency planning, documenting, and reporting requirements specified in the Consent Order.

b. We are going to replace our deteriorated outdoor sign with an electronic sign to ensure community awareness of our godly efforts, plans, and programs supporting our neighborhood community and worship opportunities.

- c. We are addressing the audio system in the sanctuary to correct recurring sound problems.
- d. We are planning to bring our Property Management Task Force back into operation to help the GB assess future property oversight. More information will be provided when available as we consider the future viability of Selah with rising maintenance and operating costs, and other property assets. I will keep you informed as we progress in our review.

We request your indulgence with cleaning and upkeep as our Custodian, Kevin, is no longer on our staff and has departed.


#### **Grow Spiritually**
