During last Sunday's church service in the Sanctuary, we enjoyed the musical Prelude by music Director Annie Arsenault, singing by our choir members, and with Pastor Doug's inspiring message. We especially enjoyed Bill Trippi's Testimony in support of the Stewardship Team's Pledge and Donation commitment drive for Operating Year 2022. What a joy to hear Bill talk of his life experiences for him and his family as members of GPC, starting with his marriage to Diane many years ago.

We have been blessed to belong to our historical church, 126 years old, that serves the community by being a house of godly worship, with our Love in Action programs and outreach ministries serving others. We are Christians who put our faith into action. We worship as a people of God, assemble in His presence to speak with Him by prayers and song, and hear Him speak to us by word and sacrament. Here are a few notes from last night's Governing Board meeting:

- **a.** The Treasurer and the Finance Team presented their initial draft Operating Budget Proposal for 2022. The Board will review and evaluate. The finalized budget will be presented during our annual meeting in January 2022.
- **b.** The Food Hub is now moving their client's equipment/materials out of Fisher Hall so we can restore our spaces to normal use.
- c. Various building maintenance items were discussed.
- **d.** The Social Media Team hasn't evolved as expected. We need a few people who understand Facebook and can send postings from our church to FB and other media sites to communicate our message and activities for community awareness. Help us with this and volunteer a little time.
- **e.** The Board agreed to donate \$250 of our Hunger Action funds to Worcester Fellowship to support their food program. We are seeking your Congregation donations to match our donation by Christmas. Please make your special donation noting Worcester Fellowship to help needy community members.
