The Music Minister is a creative, collaborative team member whose talents and vision will contribute to the ongoing transformation of Greendale People's Church, an independent, "non-denominational" congregation. In collaboration with the Pastor and Worship Teams, the Music Minister will craft and implement a vision for our music program that enhances the life and ministry of the congregation, incorporates a variety of musical styles, and inspires congregants of all ages.

Responsibilities:

- develop the vision for the music program;
- plan the musical components for worship that incorporate a variety of styles;
- plan, direct and accompany the choir in rehearsal and worship;
- provide accompaniment for congregation, soloists and the choir at Sunday Worship Services and occasional special/holiday worship services;
- identify and arrange for accompanists in the event of an absence.

Skills and Qualifications:

- experience accompanying others with piano is required, experience with other instruments such as organ, guitar, etc. is desirable, though not required;
- experience working in a positive, collaborative way to lead volunteer choirs, ensembles and/or teams;
- familiarity with a range of musical styles applicable to worship;
- affirm our core values, which include spirituality, inclusivity and healthy relationships;
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent, desired.
- Pass a background check.
